WHAT DOES GREEN LEAF¹ DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income and asset levels
- Contribution and distribution information
- Address and other contact information

When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their personal information; the reasons Green Leaf chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Green Leaf protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use appropriate security measures that include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness ▪ affiliates from using your information to market to you ▪ sharing for non-affiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>

Definitions

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Non-affiliates we share with can include investment operating partners, banks and lending agents
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
